不可**按着外貌待人**。Brothers ... must not show **favoritism**.

审判的时候,不可**看人的外貌**。 听讼不可分贵贱

Do not show partiality in judging; hear both small and great alike.

B. 一个典型例子: 优待富人、轻慢穷人 (vv. 2-3)

A Case-Study: Favor the Rich & Slight the Poor

你们就<u>重看</u>那穿华美衣服的人,说:"请坐在这好位上",又对那穷 人说:"你站在那里",或"坐在我脚凳下边"。

If you <u>show special attention</u> to the man wearing fine clothes and say, "Here's a good seat for you," but say to the poor man, "You stand there" or "Sit on the floor by my feet,"

Four Sins of Favoritism

A. 按着外貌待人不能与真信心兼容 (v. 1) Favoritism Not Compatible with True Faith

你们**信奉**我们荣耀的主耶稣基督,便**不可**按着外貌待人。 believers in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ <u>must not</u> show favoritism. -- 雅各书/James 2:1

Four Sins of Favoritism

B. 按着外貌待人是邪恶的 (v. 4) Favoritism Is Evil

这岂不是你们偏心待人,用<u>恶意</u>断定人吗? have you not discriminated among yourselves and become judges with <u>evil</u> thoughts?

Four Sins of Favoritism

C. 按着外貌待人违背神的拣选 (vv. 5-7) Favoritism Contradicts against God's Selection

神岂不是<u>拣选了世上的贫穷人</u>,叫他们在信上富足,并承受他所应 许给那些爱他之人的国吗?

Has not God <u>chosen those who are poor in the eyes of the world</u> to be rich in faith and to inherit the kingdom he promised those who love him?

-- 雅各书/James 2:5-7

Four Sins of Favoritism

D. 按着外貌待人违背律法 (vv. 8-12) Favoritism Violates the Law

但你们若按外貌待人,便是<u>犯罪</u>,被律法定为犯法的。 But if you show favoritism, you <u>sin</u> and are convicted by the law as lawbreakers.

-- 彼前/1 Peter 2:1

3. **按着外貌待人的解药: 怜悯之心** (v. 13)

Antidote of Favoritism: Mercy

A. 无怜悯的人将会面对无怜悯的审判 (v. 13a) The Merciless will Receive Merciless Judgment

因为那不怜悯人的, 也要受**无怜悯的审判**。

because <u>judgment without mercy</u> will be shown to anyone who has not been merciful.

3. **按着外貌待人的解药: 怜悯之心** (v. 13)

Antidote of Favoritism: Mercy

B. 怜悯向审判夸胜 (v. 13b)

Mercy Triumphs over Judgment

<u>**怜悯**</u>原是向审判夸胜。 <u>**Mercy**</u> triumphs over judgment.

-- 雅各书/James 2:13b
